About CASA

CASA provides abused, neglected, and exploited children with a voice in court. CASA stands for Court Appointed Special Advocates. CASA of Scotts Bluff County is a nonprofit organization whose trained volunteers serve as non-legal parties in child abuse and neglect cases within the county court system. CASA volunteers are appointed by a judge to advocate for a child's best interests. They remain involved in the case until it closes and the child is in a safe, permanent home. CASA serves children from birth through age 18, and often provides the only consistent presence when caseworkers, foster parents, and schools may change.

Volunteer Requirements

To serve as a CASA volunteer, you must:

- Be at least 21 years of age
- Consent to and pass a background check
- Have a valid driver's license/ID
- Have a valid phone number and email address
- Maintain a permanent address
- Uphold confidentiality and remain objective
- Possess effective communication skills
- Have a genuine commitment to helping children

You must also be able to:

- Complete 30 hours of training (15 online, 15 in person)
- Commit 6–10 hours per month (including continuing education)
- Complete 12 hours of continuing education annually
- Attend team meetings and make court appearances as needed
- Visit CASA children (and families, when appropriate) every 30 days
- Share your contact information with case professionals (unless otherwise directed by CASA leadership)
